Dear Applicant,

A Bible college education gives a student access to training and resources which can be used to make a profound impact on the world. It is a choice few make, but those who do consistently regard it as one of the most rewarding decisions they make in their lives. Regardless of your goals for your career and your future, the time you spend at Boise Bible College will equip you to face our world and its challenges as a servant and minister of our Lord Jesus Christ. BBC will prepare you for your life, not just a career!

This packet contains the materials you need to complete in order to gain acceptance for study at Boise Bible College. Please read through the instructions and follow them carefully, which will allow for more rapid processing of your application and prevent unnecessary delays. Application

Complete and sign the enclosed application (including the application essay). Do not leave any spaces blank; if a question does not apply to you, respond by writing or typing "N/A." A \$25.00 non-refundable application fee must be sent along with the application. Please make checks or money orders payable to Boise Bible College and note it is the application fee.

Application Photograph

A wallet-size photograph of yourself should be included with your application. The staff at BBC strives to know every applicant, and pictures are very helpful.

Recommendations

BBC requires three recommendation forms for admission: one from a minister, one from a teacher or employer, and one from a personal reference. Consult each for instructions regarding who should complete that recommendation. After completing the "Applicant's Information" portion at the top of the form, give the recommendation to the person you have chosen to complete it. Because all recommendations should be sent directly to the Admissions Office by the respondents, you should provide your reference with a stamped, pre-addressed envelope for this purpose.

Official Transcripts

High school graduates who have no college credit must arrange for an official transcript to be sent to BBC from their graduating high school. If a transcript is not available, an official copy of an applicant's GED results will also be accepted. Home school applicants should submit a transcript from a third-party agency such as a home curriculum organization or local school district. Home school graduates without a third-party transcript should contact the BBC Admissions Office for instructions regarding transcript preparation.

The Admissions Office must receive official transcripts from all colleges attended by the applicant. A high school transcript is not required of applicants who have earned 12 or more college credits.

All transcripts must be sent directly to the BBC Admissions Office by the reporting school. A final copy of your transcripts, reflecting completion of all classes and/or graduation, must be sent if the initial transcript was requested while a semester or term was in-progress. Most schools require a written request by the applicant in order to release transcripts. Transcript request forms are included in this packet.

ACT / SAT I Scores

Applicants who have been out of high school two years or less and have earned fewer than 12 college credits are required to submit either ACT or SAT I scores to the BBC Admissions Office. Scores will be sent directly to BBC if a reporting code is noted on the exam at the time of testing. BC's reporting code for the ACT exam is 0917; the reporting code for the SAT I exam is 0891. CT or SAT I scores which are included on your high school transcripts will also be accepted. (The optional ACT Writing Test is not required at BBC.)

Financial Aid and Scholarships

Complete the Financial Aid Information section of the application to be considered for scholarships and financial aid through BBC. Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) after January 1 in order to be eligible for federal student aid for the coming school year. BBC's reporting code for FAFSA is 015783; this code should be included in the appropriate section on the FAFSA. Submit the FAFSA by May 1 to guarantee disbursement of your financial aid in time for the coming school year. Forms are available from the BBC Financial Aid Office as well as from most high schools and colleges, and on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. BBC offers a variety of scholarships based on academic achievement, leadership ability, and financial need. The Financial Aid Office will begin working on your financial aid package upon acceptance.

Deadlines

Applicants who wish to enter BBC at Fall Semester must submit all required application materials by the **Priority Application Deadline of May 1** to be guaranteed consideration for scholarships through BBC. The priority deadline for Spring Semester is **December 1**. Applications completed after the Priority Application Deadline will still be considered for admission, but late applicants may lose their eligibility for scholarships offered by BBC.

The **Final Application Deadline** for Fall Semester is **August 1**, and **December 15** for the Spring Semester. In order to be guaranteed consideration for admission, all application materials must be submitted to the BBC Admissions Office by these deadlines. Applications which are completed after the Final Application Deadline are not guaranteed consideration for admission and may be subject to late fees.

It is in the applicant's best interest to apply as early as possible, which will maximize academic and scholarship opportunities and prevent unnecessary delays. It is strongly recommended that you apply by the **Early Scholarship Deadline of February 15**.

International Students

Applicants who are citizens of a country other than the United States will be required to complete the International Student Admissions Packet to be considered for admission to BBC. International students should consult the current BBC Catalog and the International Student Admissions Packet for information about applicable deadlines and additional admissions requirements.

After Admission

Applicants who are accepted to Boise Bible College will be notified by mail. An Enrollment Packet will be sent at that time. The Enrollment Packet contains an Intent to Enroll form, used by accepted students to declare their intention to enroll at BBC, and an Application for Housing and a Student Health Record for students who wish to live on campus. It also includes a Payment Plan Application for students who wish to take advantage of BBC's monthly payment plan.

Soon after acceptance, you will be contacted by the Financial Aid Office regarding your financial aid awards. Once you have completed the Enrollment Packet, the Admissions Office will contact you to pre-register for classes.
