*Reasons for not pursuing positions vary. Some students are married and their spouse supports the family. Some follow their spouse to other schools.

***Includes students who voluntarily pursue "tent-making" ministry in which they support their ministry through other employment. For some this is a temporary situation. Others intend this to be a permanent arrangement.

Adding up percentages may not result in exactly 100% because of rounding and because students for whom data was not known are included in the total count but are not placed in any of the five sub categories.

We do not break down details by degree program because student counts are so small that the information would be personally identifiable.
